However, it also reminded me of a conundrum illustrated by the exchange we had last year (attached). In the real world, practicing lawyers are more likely to come across individual quirks and problems than broader tranches of law needing reform. The "quirks" might be important. However, there is no obvious route for their discussion and correction (if appropriate).

I appreciate the limitations on the Commission's role but thought the point was worth mentioning given the broader aspects of that function.
